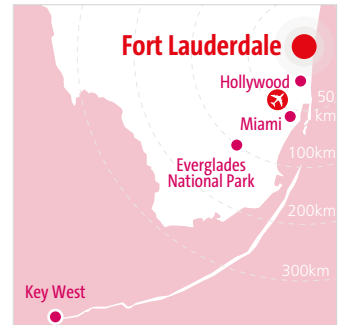
Fort Lauderdale is a modern cosmopolitan city on Florida's Gold Coast which stretches from West Palm Beach in the north to Miami in the south.
