Berkhamsted School is a private, independent school, dating back to 1541. The site retains its original school buildings whilst also offering many modern and impressive facilities. Set in the Hertfordshire town of Berkhamsted less than one hour north west of Central London, the school is set over two campuses and is ideally located for London's attractions and airports.



What do we offer?

- Junior Summer School for ages 9-12
- Summer School English for ages 12-17
- A maximum of 15 students per class
- 15 hours' English tuition per week
- Classroom and activity facilities are on-site while the accommodation buildings are located safely on a quiet street between the two campuses
- Offering both homestay (ages 12-17 only) and classic residential boarding style accommodation (ages 9-17)
- A variety of activities which include sports, arts, music, drama and dance
- Heated swimming pool, sports hall, tennis and 'fives' courts, ample playing fields allowing for a huge variety of sports
