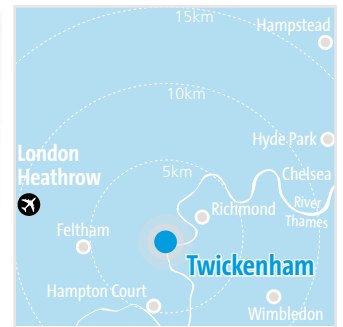
Twickenham is an affluent, safe suburb in the south-west of London.
