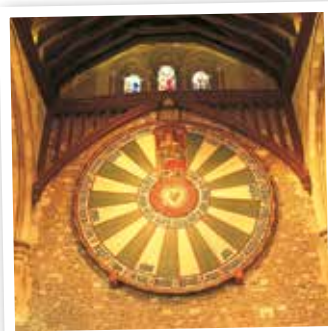
Winchester has a rich and historic range of architecture, such as the cathedral dating back to the 11th Century.



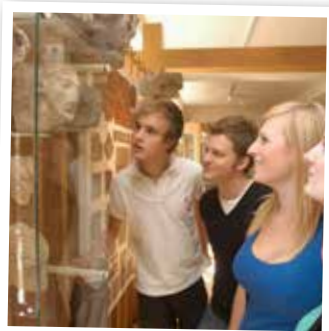
There are many great shops, restaurants and cafes in Winchester city centre.
